



Field trips at First City Art Center!

Schools are invited to come see Pensacola's only working art center!

What to expect:

- A gallery tour, where students will see some of our art studios, meet a few artists and view the current show in the gallery.
- A glass blowing demonstration in the hot shop conducted by our Glass Arts Fellow, John Shoemaker.
- A small pottery project will be offered in the classroom. Here students will make a hand built project that will be fired and returned to the school within 10 days after the field trip.



There is a lovely "art park" across the street on Guillemard St. Students are also encouraged to spend part of their trip in the park to burn off energy and walk the labyrinth.

Schools can plan on having a bag lunch either in the park or under the covered garage area of our warehouse.



The costs is \$5.00 per student.

A minimum of one chaperone for every ten students is required.

Cub Scout Art Belt Loop Field Trip

Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts are invited to earn their Art Belt Loop at First City Art Center!

Scouts will receive a tour of the campus, gallery and have a glass blowing demonstration!

They will have a lesson from an art educator on six basic elements of design. They will then do a color wheel project using paints.

Cost is \$5.00 per scout

Groups of any size are welcome! We require one chaperone for every 10 students.



Art Academic Pin Program

Scouts who have already earned their Art Belt Loop are illegible for their Art Academic Pin. First City will provide an art educator to help the boys earn this pin. This is much more intense and requires a lot more classroom time.



We encourage dens or packs to book this as a group for the best use of our teacher's time. Each day/class will last 2 hours. Please book your trip in advance so teacher can be arranged.

This program can be done after school or on weekends. The den/pack will need to work with the art center to schedule the dates that work best for all.

2 day Program includes:

Day 1- Paper Making
Pottery Project
Gallery Tour

Day 2- Photography (digital, kids will need ipad, phone, cameras)
Sculpture –upcycle project
Self Portraits using various art techniques.

***Scouts are encouraged to bring their work to a meeting to display. This completes the Pin requirements.**
