

Creative Painting Materials List

One of the goals of this class is to explore and experiment with different acrylic painting materials, supplies and techniques. There are a multitude of colors and types of acrylic paints, mediums, gels, pastes, and other products. I will demonstrate a number of them throughout the class. You are welcome and encouraged to use and experiment with any and all. Below is a list of suggested materials.

For the first day all you will need is: black and white acrylic paint, a 16x20 canvas, a few paint brushes of assorted size and shapes, a pallet to mix paint on, a water bucket, a rag and a small sketch book.

I will go over all the materials and supplies on the list below on the first day.

You will need:

**acrylic paints
palette for mixing paint
acrylic fluid medium
acrylic gel medium
rubbing alcohol
Canvases, canvas pads, or panels
Paint brushes of assorted size and shape
palette knife and scraping tools
spray bottle
water container for cleaning brushes
sketch books
drawing materials
acid free resume paper
rubber block printing blocks and cutting tools
Collage papers
scissors
hair dryer
rags
apron**

Note: A basic color palette of the colors: black, titanium white, cadmium yellow light, hansa yellow, cadmium red medium, alizarine crimson hue, ultramarine blue, and pthalo blue will mix most colors.
