Creatisphere Summer Art Camp
Teaching Opportunity

First City Art Center is currently seeking enthusiastic and creative teachers for Creatisphere Summer Art Camp. Creatisphere inspires the imagination of emerging artists through active learning, and hands-on exploration of creative mediums. The camps feature a variety of mediums, as well as incorporating STEAM, history, conservation, world cultures, yoga, and games into the weekly themes. The goal of the program is to offer engaging, creative experiences, in which children are encouraged to experiment, innovate, and CREATE.

Teachers are responsible for developing lesson plans following the weekly theme, which incorporate contextual information and history, relative vocabulary, and hands-on activities. Projects should include technique, process, and skill building, while still allowing for exploration, play, and flexibility. Duties include preparing the classroom, organizing supplies as needed, and end of the day clean-up. Teachers should be energetic, creative, positive, flexible to change, have strong classroom management skills, and enjoy working with children.

Details:

- Weekly camps offered May 30 - August 5th, 9 am - 4 pm.
- Teachers typically lead camp 4-5 hours each day.
- Class size: 8-12 campers
- FCAC instructors will teach glassblowing, not camp teachers.
- Teaching certification is not required, but is a plus.
- This is a 1099 independent contract position, no benefits are offered.
- Pay is based on experience: \$17+ per hour

Requirements:

- Available to teach +5 weeks during the summer, and work an average of 20-25 hours per week.
- Able to lift 25 lbs, and work on their feet throughout each shift.
- Degree in education, art education, studio art, a related field, or have equivalent work experience.
- Pass Background Screening
